Responsibilities:

- Use your own life experience to teach subject whenever possible
- Be willing to answer questions related to the subject and learn from participants you are teaching
- Share God's unmerited grace with the participant in word and deed
- Be ready to communicate to participants why the knowledge you are giving them is important to their life

Required Skills and Attributes:

- A Christian who believes God's word is truth and lives it out in every area of his/her life.
- A personal commitment to God's kingdom work specifically for the economically and spiritually poor
- A commitment to racial and socio-economic reconciliation at a personal level, and a willingness to foster a relationship that goes beyond stereotypes and challenges your own perspectives
- A recognition of the poor as individuals made in the image of God
- Role model for professional conduct and behavior
